PRESIDENT: Are there other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to remove the brackets on LB17 on General File. Signed Senator Wallwey.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Wallwey.

SENATOR WALLWEY: Mr. President, the questions I had on LB17 have been removed so I would suggest that Senator Holmquist go ahead with his motion to kill.

PRESIDENT: You're requesting to remove the brackets Senator. Is there a second to the motion? Senator Holmquist.

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I renew my request to indefinitely postpone LB17.
