PRESIDENT: Move to consideration of LB212.

CLERK: Read Title LB212

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Ziebarth.

SENATOR ZIEBARTH: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I move LB212 be advanced to E&R for review. This particular bill, our interim committee on education deals with, Section 79-105 and 106. It has to do with classification of school districts. We got six school district classifications in the state and this primarily deals with Class 2 and Class 3 Districts. It sets up a method whereby, census may be used to determine the school district classification and in Section 106 it permits reclassification of a Class 3 District to a Class 2 District. Previously, we have had procedure from going from Class 2 to Class 3, but not from Class 3 to Class 2. I moved LB212 be advanced to E&R.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB212 be advanced to E&R. Clerk will record the vote. Clerk read the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, no nays, 12 present and not voting and one absent and not voting. 13 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Move to consideration of LB213. Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Read Title LB213

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Ziebarth.

SENATOR ZIEBARTH: Mr. President, members of the legislature, I move LB213 be advanced to E&R for review. This bill repeals obsolete provisions of our statutes for providing state aid to so-called "weak" districts. No district is qualified under this section for many years so we must have all "strong" districts., in our state. 79-4144 requires that \$5.00 be set aside for a teacher to buy library books. That is a requirement we considered obsolete and Section 79-1401-1408 is a section that deals with normal training in High Schools has been obsolete since teachers were required to have 4 year certificates, so I move LB213 be advanced to E&R.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall LB213 be advanced to E&R? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, no nays, 13 not voting, 12 present, 1 absent not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Move to consideration of LB214.

CLERK: Read Title. LB214

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Elrod.

SENATOR ELROD: Mr. President, members of the legislature, this is a clarifying amendment and I will let Senator Ziebarth present this along with the bill.
