PRESIDENT: We're ready for consideration of bills on General File. We'll move to LB294. Clerk will read the title. Move to LB377. Are you ready to consider it?

CLERK: Read title. LB 377

PRESIDENT: Senator Morgan.

SENATOR MORGAN: I move that the amendments be attached to the bill, and that the bill be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion of the amendment. Senator Morgan has moved for the adoption of the committee amendments to the bill. All those in favor of the motion say aye, opposed say no. Amendment is added.

SENATOR MORGAN: I move that this bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB377. Is there discussion? Senator Holmquist.

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I'd like to have it explained.

SENATOR MORGAN: All right. When you're appealing, this is just a change, really in the language so that when you're appealing you can use a cash deposit in lieu of a bond. At the present time you have to post a bond and cash is not acceptable. This would make cash acceptable.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of LB377? (End of belt #3) Question is shall LB377 be advanced to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Read title. LB 334

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Kime.

SENATOR KIME: Mr. President, I moved this be moved from General File to E & R for advancement. I move we adopt the amendments.
