PRESIDENT: Move to the consideration of LB265. That's Senator Simpson's bill.

CLERK: The title has been read. There was pending from March 2 an amendment by Senator Waldron.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: We did hold this over because I wanted to take a little closer look at the amendment. I now agree with the amendment and I move for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Clerk read the amendment please.

CLERK: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: There's a motion to adopt the amendment. Do you all understand it? All in favor of the adoption of the amendment say aye, opposed say no. The amendment is adopted. Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, I move to advance LB265 to E & R for review. As I explained before and then we found this little problem. This bill is only putting into uniform (inaudible) the changes that we made in right of way in some bills in the 69 session, only codifies them into the motor vehicles code and I hope we could advance it.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of LB265? Question is shall LB265 be advanced to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, 22 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Ready for the consideration of LB208. LB208 will be held over. Clerk will read the title of LB367.

CLERK: Read title. LB 367

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: I move for the adoption of the amendments. Senator Clark isn't here.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion of the motion. Motion is to adopt the amendments. All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR KEYES: This is a very simple bill. It just means that when one city has annexed a piece of land and the annexation is declared invalid then the taxes that are due
