PRESIDENT: Ready for the consideration of bills on General File. (End of belt #2)
Move to LB242.

CLERK: Read title. LB 242
Committee amendments have been adopted. A motion now pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This pertains only to the field of mileage for sheriff as I recall. There was a discussion whether it should be 10 or 15 cents and as a matter of trying to compromise the matter, the amendment would say they should be paid not less than 12, nor more than 15 cents per mile. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: It's been moved that the amendment be adopted. All in favor of the amendment, say aye, opposed say no. Machine vote.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter withdraws the amendment. If there is no objection the amendment is withdrawn. Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, the committee amendment was adopted, right? I'd like to make a motion then that we strike the committee amendment that was adopted several days ago. This would reinstate the 15 cents then in the same motion I would like to insert starting after the period on line 8, page 5, that the following language: provided the county boards may limit the number of miles a sheriff travels if they consider it excessive. Maybe we should take them separately. First to strike the committee amendment. I'd like to take that motion first and reinstate the 15 cents.

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron, the Chair would rule this is almost a motion for reconsideration. It is because we've already adopted them. Do you want to go through that procedure then? Take 25 votes. Motion has been made to reconsider our action on the adoption of the amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Reconsideration is lost. What's the pleasure.

CLERK: There are further amendments Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron did you want to take up anymore of your amendments?
