PRESIDENT: LB267 and LB1006 are returned from Final Reading to Select File for specific amendments. (Belt #1) Chair recognizes Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB639.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the amendments to LB639. All those in favor of the motion say aye, opposed say no. The ayes have it, so ordered.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move to the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB316.

CLERK: There are none, Mr. President.

SENATOR SNYDER: I would move that LB316 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Senator, you'll have to back up just a moment. What did you decide to do with LB639.

SENATOR SNYDER: I believe we're just going to leave LB639. We're just going to adopt the amendments and leave it on Select File.

PRESIDENT: What is the situation regarding LB316?

CLERK: There is a motion pending which would need to be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: I move for the adoption of the amendment. All this amendment is to take care of Judge (inaudible) and Judge Hamilton's objection that a judge would have to hold a formal hearing to override the release recommendations. In other words, if a pre-child release agency made a recommendation, these two judges felt they would have to hold a hearing to decide that. That was not the intent at all. These amendments make it clear that the judges would not have to hold a separate hearing and that's all there is to them.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the amendment? All those in favor of adopting the amendment say aye, opposed say no. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I would move that LB316 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB316 as amended to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. LB316 is advanced.
