PRESIDENT: We will now move to General File. We'll take up first 639A.

CLERK: The title has been read.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Wallwey.

SENATOR WALLWEY: At this time, I'd like to ask unanimous consent that my name be removed from 639A.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wallwey asked unanimous consent to have his name removed from 639A. Are there any objections?

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I'd object until my name is added. That way we'll make sure that we don't get into a controversy over whether the thing is alive or dead. I'd ask that my name be added and Senator Wallwey's be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: I ask that my name be put on.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer asked that his name be added to 639A. Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I make the same request that mine be added also.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers asked that his name be added to 639A. Are there any objections? Chair hearing none, so ordered. We're ready to take it up. What's your pleasure? Senator Marvel did you have any statements on 639A? What shall we do with 639A.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move we advance it to E & R for initial.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance 639A to E & R. Ready for the question? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted?

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. We'll now take up LB189. We're bypassing LB189. Move to LB450.

CLERK: Read title. LB 450

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Elrod.

SENATOR ELROD: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I'll move the adoption of the committee amendments. And then I'll ask Senator Ziebarth to explain them when he's explaining the bill as they were brought in by Mr. Ziebarth's representative, Mrs. Campbell.
