PRESIDENT: The first bill on General File this morning will be 725, next will be 868, and then 287.

CLERK: LB725, the title has been read. There is now pending the Maresh amendment #2, again to the committee amendment.
Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: We all know that this licensing program has been set up by the Motor Vehicle Department and we need a temporary system to hold this over until a permanent system is set up. I make a motion that this system be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Senator Holmquist.

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I wonder if Senator Maresh would yield to a question. You quoted a figure of one dollar, does this pertain to 13 year olds.

SENATOR MARESH: Yes that would include them.

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: This permit is for what length of time?

SENATOR MARESH: For 6 months.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the Maresh amendment? All those in favor of this amendment, say aye, opposed say no. The ayes have it, so ordered.

CLERK: Read further motion.

SENATOR MARESH: The reason for this is it appeared we were in conflict with federal regulations which applied to 14 and above that work on other farms besides their parents. So we inserted this 14 years of age or older and it clarifies this part of the amendment. I move that this be adopted.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of the amendment say aye, opposed say no. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I move that the bill as amended be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: We'll need to adopt the committee amendments.

SENATOR MARESH: I so move.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments say aye, opposed say no. They're adopted.

CLERK: Further motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will read the motion.
