PRESIDENT: We're ready to proceed to General File. We'll take up LB868. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, yesterday I made a motion to reconsider action on LB868. If we reconsider for example - Senator Proud would like to have an attempt to advance it again.

PRESIDENT: I would suggest you drop your motion to reconsider and let Senator Proud make whatever motion he wants.

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President, I move to advance the bill. We debated this matter at length yesterday. I see no reason for further debate. If somebody wants to then I am ready, but other than that I feel we should now vote. I either have 25 votes or I don't have them. I urge you to vote green and I would ask for a record vote.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Holmquist.

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, through most of the debate yesterday, I think it was brought out that this all pertains to the annexation of Millard. I want to say that it really pertains to annexation of any town of Douglas County. I think this is the important thing whether or not it does advance.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Question is shall 868 be advanced to E & R. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? (End of belt #3) Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 20 nays, 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is not advanced.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be indefinitely postponed.

PRESIDENT: Motion to indefinitely postpone. Question is shall the bill 868 be postponed. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 16 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion is carried. The bill is indefinitely postponed. Take up LB152.

CLERK: Read title. LB 152

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, this has been a very involved bill, the latest problem we have is whether or not the bill in its suggested form meets the requirements
