PRESIDENT: Move to the consideration of LB387.

CLERK: Read title. LB 387

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, this bill came from the Director of Agriculture. It is more or less a housekeeping bill. It provides that the Director of Agriculture has authority by regulation to set specifications for the equipment used in butter fat testing provided that the specifications comply with those drawn up by the Association of Official Analytical Chemists. This amendment will allow the department to provide for the use of the new bottle by the regulations. My understanding is that the company that the department purchased these original bottles from, had discontinued this production and they have had to go to another company for this product. This merely provides for him to do so. I move for the advancement.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of LB387. Question is shall LB387 be advanced to E & R for initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB513.

CLERK: Read title. LB 513

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Wiltse.

SENATOR WILTSE: The purpose of this bill is to provide facility for the use of this public lands in case of need for the storage of water in water districts in depleted areas specifically in the extreme northwest section of the state and the southeast section of the state. It provides for a method of using educational lands for the storage of water.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of LB513. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, 13 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Next is LB658.

CLERK: Read title. LB 658
