PRESIDENT: Move to the consideration of LB152. The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I would like to have this bill bracketed.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter has asked unanimous consent to have this bill bracketed until Monday. Are there any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Move to the consideration of LB232. LB232 is withdrawn. Move to the consideration of LB658. Clerk will read the title. Senator Simpson--

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, I would like to lay that over. Senator Whitney has an amendment and I would like to hold it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson has asked for unanimous consent to lay over LB658. Are there any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. The bill is laid over. Move to the consideration of LB122.

CLERK: The title on LB122 has been read and the committee amendments have been adopted.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers has asked for unanimous consent to have his name added to LB122. Are there any objections? Hearing none, it is so ordered.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. Chairman, I would move that LB122 be advanced to E & R. We discussed this bill at length yesterday and I move the previous question.

SENATOR STAHMER: Senator Barnett, has this bill been checked out or have any opinions been given by the Attorney General?

SENATOR BARNETT: As I stated yesterday Senator Stahmer, this bill has been sent to the Attorney General's office. The committee members have read the Attorney General's opinion and this is the way it came out of the committee after their discussion over the Attorney General's opinion.

SENATOR SYAS: Everybody is in the bill from second-class cities on up. Is that it? (End of Belt #6)

PRESIDENT: Senator Skarda, can you answer his question?
