PRESIDENT: Move to the consideration of LB567. Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Read title. LB 567.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Skarda.

SENATOR SKARDA: Mr. President, Members of the Body, The first amendment that you have is the only one I am interested in presently is the one that precludes candy, including food. So now it will be food and candy excluded in the sales tax. I move for the adoption.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? The question is shall the Skarda amendment be accepted. All those in favor say aye, all those opposed say no. We will have a vote on it. All those in favor of adopting the Skarda amendment to LB567 vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the Skarda amendment to LB567 which would exempt candy. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 19 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is lost. There are further amendments to LB567.

CLERK: Read amendments.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Skarda.

SENATOR SKARDA: That is just a correction in the bill in the wording and I move it be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Senator Holmquist--

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: Besides losing 17 points, what else does it do when it refers to 4 instead of 21?

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the motion? The question is shall the motion be adopted? Senator Holmquist.

SENATOR HOLMQUIST: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, (End of Belt #11) for Senator Skarda's information it just refers to what is classified as food.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of adopting the amendment, vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 2 nays Mr. President.
