PRESIDENT: Move to General File.

CLERK: Read title. LB 679A

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment upon the understanding these amendments were brought to me by Mr. Rein who says they're necessary in order to put the bill in the proper form. I move for their adoption.

CLERK: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment. All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. The amendment then is adopted.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Question is shall LB679A and -- be advanced to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for initial.

CLERK: Read title. LB 680A

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that the amendment be adopted, upon the understanding these are amendments brought in by Mr. Rein who says they're necessary in order to have the bill in proper form.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment. All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for initial.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall LB680A be advanced to E & R for initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.
