SENATOR MARVEL: Page 2 of the bill, line 6 and 7, discusses Agency 13, State Department of Education. On line 9, we are talking about aid to public schools, aid to junior colleges basically. Line 292, is special education which includes aid to the trainable retarded, \$265,984. together with 178-A is the total funding for the trainable, aid to educable retarded, \$1,116,546.00. Aid to the physical handicapped, 661,845. and aid to the emotionally disturbed, \$34,625.00. 294 is vocational school aid, which basically is aid to area vocational schools, nursing educational aid and the regular vocational aid. A great deal of this money goes directly to the political sub-division, directly to the public schools. Section 3, Agency 16, line 21, you will find \$5,800,000. which is homestead exemption money directly to the political sub-division. Next page is page 4, line 2, \$5,000,000. goes to airport development. Section 5 is the Department of Agriculture. Line 15 and 16 are scholarship to world youth which is a program set up some time ago. The bottom of page 4, Department of Health, Agency 20, and on the next page at the top, page 5, line 1, supporting services to public health districts, lines 2 and 3, maternal child health grants. Department of Public Institutions is line 12. Line 15 and 16 have to do with the Office of Mental Retardation which includes a 50% increase in this particular program. Department of Public Welfare, lines 19 and 20 include aid in regard to public welfare. Next page -

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: In the area of public welfare which shows a total of \$81,000,000. million dollars for a year. How much of an increase in general terms is that over the previous year?

SENATOR MARVEL: I will pass over it and come back to it later. We will go on to - on the top of page 6, the military department agency 31 includes 3 small items in civil defense and emergencies, Board of Educational Land and Funds, Agency 32 includes lines 14 and 15, school employees, service and etc. Public Library Commission, Section 12, Lines 18 and 19, includes state aid to library development. Next page, state racing commission includes 4H-Club contribution, line 3 and 4. Soil and water conservation, Section 14, lines 14 and 15 includes state aid to small water sheds. Next one is Department of Roads, State Patrol has 2 small items at the top. Program 195 is Thurston County money. Page 8, lines 1 and 2. Agency 65 clear to line 7, community planning.
