PRESIDENT: Senator Syas will take up LB1035.

SENATOR SYAS: This is the reapportioning --

CLERK: Read title.

LB 1035

SENATOR SYAS: I move that LB1035 be advanced to E & R for initial. What this bill does, we have an eight member Board of Regents. We must reapportion as you know, on the 1970 census. The bill is on your desk, it was introduced the other day. You know what it's all about it's putting them in eight districts equally and proportionately. I so move.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of LB1035. Question is shall LB1035 be advanced. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, 16 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB735 is next.

CLERK: Read title.

LB 735

PRESIDENT: Senator Ziebarth.

SENATOR ZIEBARTH: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I move LB735 be advanced to E & R initial. Mr. President, the Clerk has amendments to this that will conform to Senator Syas's 1035. It changes the language. The bill does exactly the same thing as Senator Syas's and I asked Mr. Stanley to poll the State Board of Education. They had no objections or criticisms. I move that LB735 be advanced to E & R initial. I move for the adoption of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of the amendments? All those in favor say aye, opposed to them say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR ZIEBARTH: I move LB735 be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, 17 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.
