PRESIDENT: First bill for consideration will be LB545.
Senator Wallwey.

SENATOR WALLWEY: I'd concede to Senator Syas.

PRESIDENT: The bill then will be LB651.

CLERK: Read title. LB 651

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature,
I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

This is an agreed bill between both parties, interested in the bill. There was extensive committee amendments here which they are not argumentative amendments. They have been agreed from both sides, however there is a little mistake in the Standing Committee amendments in the drafting of them and I offered an amendment to the Standing Committee amendments, which are correctional amendments. I don't believe there's any need to go into extensive discussion of the amendments as long as both sides agree. I would move the adoption of the committee amendments as amended.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the committee amendments be adopted. All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. They're adopted.

CLERK: Further amendment.

SENATOR MOYLAN: These were as I just mentioned the corrective amendments to the Standing Committee amendments. In the drafting of the Standing Committee amendments, there were some mistakes made. I move there adoption also.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the Moylan amendment be adopted. All those in favor say aye, opposed say no. They're adopted. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I move the bill as amended be advanced. This is a comprehensive bill, a very important bill, but what it actually does is bring the state into compliance with federal standards which I understand we are now not in compliance. Secondly this is an agreed bill between the management and labor on this whole bill. They both testified in favor of the bill at the committee hearing and there was no opposition.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall LB651 as amended be advanced to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.
