PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments to LB330-A.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB330-A. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB330-A be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB330-A. Is there need for discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, all those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB1038 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB1038. Is there need for discussion? Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I have 4 amendments up there that I would like to discuss. The first amendment is one that takes care of the major repairs at the Chadron Armory. The second one takes care of two items concerning a children's rehab. institute money from the voc-rehab. funds. In connection with this the eye institute and the clinic from federal funds and private donations, the second part of amendment two takes care of Department of Labor building which comes out of their separate fund. The third amendment takes care of small amounts that was not reappropriated for Peru Science building and the fourth one takes care of reappropriation amounts for the emergency fund. There is two items here. Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to have these four amendments adopted to LB1038. I would like to ask unanimous consent that amendment number one that has to do with the armory at Chadron be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections? Hearing none, so ordered and number one is adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: Amendment number two has to do with the items that I discussed in connection with the children's rehab. institute, med. center and also the Department of Labor building.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections? Hearing none, number two is adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: The third amendment has to do with the \$710. item Science building at Peru.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections for that motion?

SENATOR MARVEL: The fourth one has to do with the re-appropriations and the emergency account. There are two of them.
