CLERK: Motion to return LB776 to Select File.

SENATOR SCHMIT: The reason for these amendment Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, are that the section that deals with the amount of tax refunds money going back to the farmer was changed from $7\frac{1}{2}$ to $7\frac{3}{8}$, so that section number had to be included in the new material. Then as referred to the committee it's unconstitutional for members of the Executive Board to appoint the members of the committee, therefore it had to be done by the Governor subject to the confirmation by the Legislature. Then we added the severability clause and that's all we did. I move the bill be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return the bill.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I so move.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall LB776 be returned to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? Question is shall the amendment to LB776 be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Clerk will record the vote. Clerk will read the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of the readvancement of LB776 say aye, opposed say no. The bill is returned. The rules are suspended, we'll take up LB256 on Select File.

CLERK: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: This would strike the 35 as was originally in 573. It would be an exemption of 20% in '72, an additional 20% in '73 an additional 10% in '74. It would stop at a total of 50% exemption. The amendment I offered yesterday would have permitted another 10 to make it 60 then 70, then 90. All reference to anything
