CLERK: Reference Committee Report LB1043 - LB1074 has been referred to General File. Signed, William S. Swanson, Chairman.

The vote shall be taken correction. The vote so taken shall be made a part of the committee report and then to delete the following and shall be entered in the daily journal. In-as-much-as that was an error in the rules. Signed Senator Warner. And then its been ammended to include I move to ammend rule 5 section 5d line 1 by deleting the word may again to take out a misprint in the present rules.

We have new bills Mr. President LB1116 introduced by Duke Snyder of the 14th continuing committee such as this was is impowered under LB1013 to go ahead and proceed this way Senator.

Senator: Even though we'd have no regular hearing dates while were adjourned and that sort of thing we have no regular hearing scheduled regular time to meet and that sort of thing.

PRESIDENT: Thats the chairs understanding.

SENATOR: I don't know, what?

PRESIDENT: I'll advise that they be brought back for public hearing, yes.

SENATOR: I know the public hearing, but they introduced it you see, we have a law where only one man can introduce a bill other than committees. But this committee was not in a regular they did this while we were adjourned. Unless they had a meeting today. I'm merely raising a technical question that were allowed to open up here, because I can hold a meeting of my committees during the time we adjourned and get everybody to sign it and you see what we are getting into.

PRESIDENT: Lets recognize Senator Luedtke who may have some collaboration here. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. LB1013 I'll get a copy of it here answers your questions Senator Syas it does permit this committee which is something new in the Legislature is a continuing committee which is really the beginning of a system of the standing committee being an interim study committee. But when we introduced the bill, we introduced the bill as the judiciary committee. We have already voted to do so as the Judiciary Committee. And the vote was unanimous on every one of these bills as far as introducing them. Everybody who was there voted for it. And we have had good attendance. But LB1013 does provide that we may do so. This is law, a law of the state of Nebraska which was signed by the Governor. Its not by the rules of the Legislature under this law a standing committee of the Legislature does the work and brings in the bill but its got to be signed in by a standing committee of the Legislature which is the Judiciary Committee. Thats the way it works.
