: Mr. President and members of the legislature I ask for unanimous consent to take up tomorrow's final reading today.

CLERK: Read the vote: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Rules are suspended. We'll take up those on final reading for tomorrow today.

CLERK: I ask unanimous consent to have LB 311 moved to Monday for final reading, signed Senator Stahmer.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to bypassing 311 on the final reading today and holding it till Monday? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. 311 will be bypassed. We'll move to the final reading of 719. Will you please clear the floor. We're almost ready for the final reading of LB 719. Attention please. The final reading, the blue copy of LB 719.

CLERK: Read title LB 719

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the final passage of LB 719. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.
