CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB674 be moved back to Select File for specific amendment. This is not changing the concept of the bill as it is presently amended, but there are a couple of problems with the amendment as far as the wording is concerned. One of the problems is that the way the amendment was originally adopted it required that the notice to the tax payer be included with both the notice and the receipt of the taxes and it was intended to be or a one or the other it would not be possible in some cases to put them out with the notice because of the way it is handled, but it would be no problem with the receipt. So, that is the one change, and the other change is that if you were looking at amendment number one of the bill as it stands now, I think it is a little confusing it talks about the total amount of tax levied by the county, the city to be on the sheet the school district and the that isn't too clear exactly what that means, so the amendment would end up that on the sheet you would show the amount of state aid to each of these individual subdivisions within the county. The information to be provided to the county treasurer by the tax commission office and the state is the only one that can do this. In the County Treasurer Assessor would put on the notices of the amount of taxes that were to be raised locally and then there is the additional sentence to be printed on each sheet that I forget the exact words but to the affect that your local property taxes would have been increased by the amount of state aid shown if it were not for the action of the legislature.
