CLERK: Have a request to be excused until he arrives, his flight from Scotts Bluff was delayed on account of weather, signed Senator Carpenter.

SPEAKER: Objections. Hearing none, so ordered. Do we have any notices of committee hearings, or reports.

CLERK: Have a message from the Governor.

SPEAKER: Read the message.

CLERK: Message read.

SPEAKER: Thank you.

CLERK: I have an Attorney General's opinion.

SPEAKER: Just a second please, the Chair recognizes Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. Speaker, members of the legislature, the fiscal staff ordered, contacted me earlier last week and they suggested that probably the A bill for LB 40 had been over figured too much money in it, and so at this time, I have no plans to over ride the veto.
