PRESIDENT: Will the Legislature come to order. We will have the prayer by Dr. Robert Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I would like to be excused this morning about 9:30 until approximately 11:00.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? If not, so ordered. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Any petitions or memorials?

CLERK: Mr. President your committee on Enrollment and Review reports that we have examined and reviewed LB790 and recommend that it be replaced on Select File as amended. 616, on Select File as amended, and 763 Select File as amended. Signed, John Cavanaugh, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: A....

CLERK: Mr. President, your Chairman or committee on E & R reports that we have examined and reviewed 228 and find the same correctly enrolled, 228A correctly enrolled and 697 correctly enrolled, signed John Cavanaugh, Chairman. Mr. President, notice of committee hearings (read, regarding LB1042). Mr. President, the Committee on Committees desires to report on some appointments that they have considered, signed by Senator Whitney, the report will be set out in full in the Journal. PRESIDENT: We are ready for Final Reading. Will the Senators please take their seats. It is time for Final Reading. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: (mike not activated for the first part of the statement) and read the bills that are set for tomorrow today. There are quite a number of them but they are not very long.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to suspend the rules and read the bills on Final Reading that were set for tomorrow but read them today. Those in favor, it takes 30 votes. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, Mr. President.
