PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis and Cavanaugh asked to be excused until they arrive. Senator Kelly asked to be excused until he arrives. Senator Wiltse asked to be excused on Thursday and Friday.

PRESIDENT: Record.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Corrections read. See Page 1606, Journal. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections to the Journal from the floor? Seeing none, the Journal shall be corrected and shall stand.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have received a communication from the Administrator of the Department of Agriculture, Packer and Stockyard Administration, acknowledging receipt of our Legislative Resolution dealing with the payment for purchase of beef. He has attached thereto a press release. This information will be on file in my office for anyone wishing to look at it. Mr. President, we have also received a communication from Senator Roman Hruska acknowledging the receipt of Legislative Resolution dealing with the O'Neill and North Loup Reclamation Projects and said that he supports these proposals. We have also received a letter from Senator Hruska acknowledging receipt of Legislative Resolution #31 regarding payment of purchases of meat products and urging the Department of Agriculture to take the necessary steps to protect this particular aspect of the industry. He forwards a copy of Senate bill #1532 which will be on file in my office for anyone wishing to see it. That is all, Mr. President. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports that we have examined and reviewed LB 259 and recommend that it be replaced on Select File as amended; 508 replaced on Select File as amended; 235A Select File as amended; 421 Select File as amended; 526 Select File as amended; 507 Select File as amended; and 423 Select File as amended.
