PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

REV. HEZMALL: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Record your presence, please. The Legislature will come to order. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis asked to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Have you recorded your presence, Senators? Entering the Chamber under the South balcony is one of the venerable senators in the history of this Legislature, Albert Kjar of Lexington. Senator Kjar, we are very happy to have you back.

CLERK: Senator Schmit asked to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections in the Journal from the floor? Mr. Clerk, do you have any corrections?

CLERK: Read corrections. See page 232, Journal. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to those corrections? The Journal shall stand as corrected. Committee hearings and reports, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp gives notice, I think it is a renotece, of a public hearing for Rules Committee today at 12:30 p.m. It is simply a renotece. Mr. President, Legislative Resolution 108 is ready for signature. Mr. President, Senator Luedtke asked to be excused on Friday, the 16th.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign Legislative Resolution 108. The Chair recognizes Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, there was two errors in reference of bills. I would like to ask the Legislature for unanimous consent. One was in the reference of LB 30A, it was referred to the Appropriations Committee when it should have been placed on General File as provided in the Rules and it was overlooked, the fact that it was an "A" bill when it comes in. And then, Mr. President, LB 666, which was a constitutional amendment, was inadvertently referred to the Education Committee through a clerical error and it should have been referred to Constitutional Revision and Recreation. So my motion is that by unanimous consent that LB 30A and 666 be rereferred to the appropriate committees, 30A to General File, and 666 from Education to Constitutional Revision.
