SPEAKER: The Legislature will come to order please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Anderson and Senator Johnson asked to be excused today and Senator Fitzgerald asks to be excused until he arrives. Senator F. Lewis asks to be excused until he arrives.

SPEAKER: Have you all recorded your presence? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

SPEAKER: We are ready to **conduct** business. Are there any corrections in the Journal?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Any committee hearings or reports?

CLERK: Read communication from the Governor regarding 585, 629, 649 and 696.

Mr. President there is an Attorney General's Opinion that will be inserted in the Journal addressed to Senator R. Maresh.

SPEAKER: Introduction of any new bills?

CLERK: Mr. President your committee on E & R reports that we have examined and reviewed LB666 and recommend that the same be replaced on Select File. Legislative Bill 313 be placed on Select File as amended. LB 65 and find the same correctly Engrossed.

Mr. President, your committee of Government, Military and Veterans Affairs to whom is referred LB902 instructs me to report the same legislation be advanced to General File as amended. 821 General File as amended, wait a minute, Government Committee is Senator Rasmussen.
