

EIGHTY-FOURTH LEGISLATURE
FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

October 22, 1975

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will please call the roll.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stoney asked to be excused until October 27th and Senator Koch asked to be excused until October 27th. Oh, Senator Koch is present.

PRESIDENT: Please indicate your presence. Roll call. Have you all indicated your presence? Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk reports that a quorum is present. Senator Fitzgerald indicates his presence. I have a declaration to be read. (Read declaration from Governor found on page 2 in the Journal). Would the Clerk please read the proclamation.

CLERK: Read proclamation and letter from Mr. Beerman and the Governor found on pages 2 thru 4 in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten asked that the Chair make a special announcement. There is, at the front of the chamber right in front of the Clerk, a box of light apples and a box of red apples. Senator Carsten claims that the 2nd Legislative District is the apple capital of the world. Those are for the use and benefit of the Senators. Is that enough Senator Carsten?

Mr. Clerk, you have some motions.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on the desk. I move that the officers elected to serve in the 84th Legislature, 1st Session, serve in this the 84th Legislature, 1st Special Session. For Clerk Vincent Brown; Assistant Clerk Walt Radcliffe; Sergeant-At-Arms Ray Wilson; Chaplain Dr. Robert Palmer. Signed, Senator Anderson.

PRESIDENT: Is there a second of that motion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, contrary nay. The motion carries.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that the rules of the 84th Legislature be used in this the First Special Session. Signed, Senator Cal Carsten.

PRESIDENT: Is there a second of the motion? Senator Goodrich seconds it. All those in favor signify by saying aye, contrary say nay. Motion carries.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that the membership of the committees of the 84th Legislature be continued in this the First Special Session and that the membership of all standing, select and special committees be the same as during the 84th regular session. Signed, Senator Moylan.
