SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Legislature will please come to order.
Prayer by Chaplain Van Ham.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Thank you Chaplain. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers, Senator Venditte and Senator Koch asked to be excused until they arrive. Senator Newell asked to be excused for the day.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That will be so ordered, until they arrive. Who was that for the day?

CLERK: Newell.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: So ordered. Record the vote.
