PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order. Roll call. Have you all recorded your presence. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Koch asked to be excused till he arrives. Senator Frank Lewis asked to be excused till he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Do you have corrections to the Journal, Mr. Clerk? Are there corrections to the Journal from the floor? Seeing none, it shall stand. Notices, reports, committee hearings and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 50 and recommend it be placed on Select File as amended; LB 82 Select File. Signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman. Mr. President, Banking, Commerce and Insurance gives notice of an altered notice of committee hearing. Signed, Senator DeCamp, Chairman. Mr. President, your Committee on Public Works gives notice of committee hearing. Signed, Senator Kremer, Chairman. Revenue notice of committee hearing. Signed, Senator Keyes, Chairman.
