PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. The Legislature will be in order.  
Record your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch asked to be excused till he arrives. Mr. President, the Appropriations Committee asked to be excused on Friday until they return.

PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: (Read corrections found on page 1212 of the Journal).

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections from the floor? Is there an objection to this one? It shall stand as read. Reports, announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, there will be inserted in the Legislative Journal a report of lobbyists who have registered with my office for the past week. Mr. President, there is a Reference Committee Report referring LB 525 to the Business and Labor Committee, 526 to the Appropriations Committee. Mr. President, we have received a communication from the Commonwealth of Virginia, forwarding a joint resolution from the Commonwealth of Virginia, calling upon the Congress to call a Constitutional Convention for the purpose of amending the United States Constitution, to provide the President with the power to veto any particular item, or items in an appropriation bill.

Mr. President, Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee gives notice of an executive session for Monday at 8:30 in Room 2230. Signed, Senator DeCamp. That is all, Mr. President.
