LB 347, 518, 531, 524

PRESIDENT: All rise for a moment of contemplation. The Legislature will please come to order. Roll call, please record your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers asks to be excused until he arrives. Senator Koch and Boughn until they arrive. Senator Murphy asks to be excused for the day. Senator Burrows and Brennan ask to be excused until they arrive. Also, Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, are you present? Thank you. Record.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections from the floor? Seeing none the Journal shall stand. Notices, reports and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on E & R reports that we have examined and reviewed LB 347 and find the same correctly engrossed, 518 and 531 correctly engrossed. Signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: We go now to Final Reading. All Senators are to be at their desks. The Speaker has changed the agenda slightly on Final Reading. We have two bills, LB 524 and LB 522 will be up for Final Reading this morning. Please return to your desks promptly so that we can commence Final Reading. While we are waiting for the Senators to return to their desks we have some guests with us this morning. Senator Richard Maresh asked me to introduce under the north balcony Brenda Mussman from Tobias and a former page Debbie Lee. Would you both stand and be recognized. It is good to see you back Deb.
