

MR. PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

REV. WALLACE E. EASTER: Morning Prayer.

MR. PRESIDENT: The Legislature will come to order.
Roll call. Record your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marvel would like to be excused until he arrives and Senator Moylan would like to be excused until 10:00 this morning. Senator Schmit would like to be excused until he arrives, Mr. President. Senator Labeledz would like to be excused until she arrives.

MR. PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence? Make the record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

MR. PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have none, Mr. President.

MR. PRESIDENT: Are there corrections from the floor? Seeing none the Journal shall stand. Notices, reports, and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed Legislative Bill 2 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with amendments and that's signed by Senator Cullan, Chairman. Mr. President, your Committee on Appropriations whose Chairman is Senator Warner to whom you referred Legislative Bill 4 respectfully reports the legislation back to the Legislature with a recommendation that same be advanced to General File. Signed by Senator Warner. Mr. President, I have a lobbyist registration report for changes occurring during the month of May, 1978.

Chaulk, State Board of Health, Mr. Dempsey McNeil to the Nebraska Natural Resources Commission, Mrs. Nancy Van Pelt to the Nebraska Arts Council and Irving R. Dana to the Nebraska Arts Council.
