PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will come to order. Prayer by the Chaplain, Reverend Wallace Easter, Westminster Presbyterian Church. Reverend Easter.

REVEREND EASTER: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hoagland asked to be excused for the balance of the day.

PRESIDENT: So ordered. Have you all recorded your presence?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Burrows would like to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: So ordered. Have you all recorded your presence? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum present. Are there any corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Read corrections. (See page 94, Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Are there any notices, reports or announcements, Mr. Clerk? The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I move we adopt the Rules as now in our possession for today only.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the Rules in your possession for this day only. This is a continuation of the Rules. Is there any discussion? This will require 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays on the motion offered by Senator DeCamp, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted and the Rules are approved for this day only. Before we get to the introduction of new bills, the Chair recognizes the Speaker, Senator Marvel, for a few remarks.
