PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Prayer by Chaplain Dr. Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pirsch, Senator Lewis and Senator Newell would like to be excused until they arrive.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Have you all registered your presence for the roll call? Record the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: ...necessary to adopt rules for the day, the Chair recognizes Senator Fowler for that purpose.

CLERK: Senator Fowler moves that we adopt the rules as now in our possession for today only, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Motion to adopt the last session's rules for this day only. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the rules for today only vote aye, opposed nay. It will require thirty votes. Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The Fowler motion is adopted. The rules are adopted for this legislative day only. Corrections to the Journal, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no corrections to the Journal.
