SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Roll Call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Venditte, Merz, Schmit and Pirsch would like to be excused until they arrive.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined and reviewed LB 573 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with amendment; LB 380 Select File with amendments; LB 514 Select File; LB 282 Select File.
