PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Yes, the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I would alert the Legislature that this is a good day. I don't have any attention so we will have to wait a minute.

PRESIDENT: All right, would everyone give their undivided attention to the Speaker. He has an important announcement.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If you will check the agenda you will find under General File and Select File a series of bills that we can get through today if we will proceed with all due diligence. I think the discussions that we have had the last two days have been somewhat illuminating but I think the time has come now to move and, therefore, I would suggest that as rapidly as we can and still being fair we move down the General File path and then take the Select File path and we should be able with cooperation to get through this agenda today which will be the first time this particular session. I would call your attention that we are in the eleventh day today. So if someone is not here to take up his or her bill I think we should move on ahead and pick them up later. So I hope, Mr. President, that we can move with due speed to try to clear this particular #5 and #6.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Record the presence, Mr. Cierk. While we are clearing the board, Senator Kremer, did you wish to make an announcement?

SENATOR KREMER: No, not an announcement. Mr. Chairman, I would like to ask the Speaker a question in response to the announcement that he just made if I may please?

PRESIDENT: Oh, all right. Speaker Marvel, Senator Kremer has a question about the lineup I guess today. Proceed, Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Speaker Marvel, in response to your announcement, you will recall that yesterday morning when the chairmen were in session with you we discussed bills on Select File.
