SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: (Mike off) come to order and we will have prayer by the Chaplain.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Roll call. Have you all recorded your presence? As soon as you have recorded your presence, will you please turn to the agenda? (Gavel) Unless we can have pretty substantial order in this Chamber today, we are not going to finish the work that we could do and some of you disagree with the push that is being made but I am going to continue unless somebody clobbers me. Now would you all take your agenda and let me tell you what we have tried to do. We have tried to fit in the categories that agree with the worksheet. That is the only way I know of, that is the only way I know of to do the job fairly. Now if you will take General File and you will take...we start with 533 and 533A, then we go to 739 and then we go to 738 and 738A. I am asking you to follow General File, 5 (a). It is the agenda, the green sheet. If you don't have a green sheet, send for one. Does everybody have a green sheet? Okay. All right, let me start over again. You have got 533, 533A, 739 on the sheet, and then off to the side put 738, which comes after 739, 738A, 891, 776, then go down to right after 630A, put 906, and right above 705 put 956, and then after 832 put 978, and after 704 put 779 and 840 and then after 829 put 990. Now what this should do, and any of you who during the morning find that this is not true, if you'll please let me know, this is an attempt to be as fair as possible using about three different types of lists that came from you or your Chairman in an attempt to then follow the worksheet which you also have a copy of or you can get a copy of. Now I am sorry for the need to explain and to change. Senator Kahle, do you have a question?

SENATOR KAHLE: Yes, Mr. Speaker, is there a time schedule on this or are we going to just work at General File this morning (interruption)?
