SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: The prayer this morning will be offered by Senator Peterson, Senator Howard Peterson, that is.

SENATOR H. PETERSON: Prayer offered.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Roll call, please. Have you all recorded your presence, please? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I would like to draw your attention to the agenda for the day, especially pages 2, 3 and 4. You will note that you have been assigned people to escort into the Legislature's sanctuary so please be ready to go at the time this afternoon when you are escorting these notables into our legislative body. Senator Wesely, since Senator Hoagland is not here would you make the motion to adopt temporary rules for us, please?

SENATOR WESELY: The rules that are in our possession at this time would be adopted for today, January 6, only.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. You have heard the motion. All those in favor signify by voting aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of temporary rules.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Mr. Clerk, do you have some messages for us?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, first of all Senator Chronister would like to have a brief meeting of the Committee on Committees directly in the back of the Chamber on the north side, the Committee on Committees in the back of the Chamber on the north side, that to be convened immediately.
