SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Reverend Charles Wildman of the Vine Congregational Church in Lincoln, Nebraska. Welcome, Reverend Wildman.

REVEREND WILDMAN: (Prayer offered.)
