SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

LR 93, 105

SPEAKER NICHOL: Good morning. We have as our Chaplain this morning one of our own, Senator Lowell Johnson.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you, Senator Lowell, we appreciate it. Roll call, please. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: How about corrections today, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Messages, reports, announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first report is that LR 93 is ready for your signature. The message that I have is that Senator Beutler, DeCamp, Goodrich, Jacobson, Johnson, Johnson, Remmers, Withem, Beutler, Landis, Fowler, Rupp, Schmit, Nichol, Haberman and Pirsch would like to add their names to LB 363 as coinroducers.

SPEAKER NICHOL: No objection, so ordered.

CLERK: The announcement, Mr. President, is that Senator Sieck would like to print amendments to LB 604. (See page 2040 in the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 93. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I believe Senator Wesely slept in this morning. Senator Beyer, are you ready to go on LR 105?

SENATOR BEYER: Yes. Mr. Speaker and colleagues, as you all know I have been quite heavily involved in the transportation industry over the past thirty-three, thirty-four years, I guess. So with that, I again come before you with a resolution honoring the transportation industry in the United States and the State of Nebraska especially. This includes both rail, air and water, and the motor truck transportation, of course. This is one time that I can really support the railroads which is a little bit unusual, but with all modes of transportation in
