PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Today our chaplain is the pastor of the Central Church of the Nazarene in Omaha, the Reverend Daniel Casey. Reverend Casey.

REVEREND DANIEL CASEY: (Prayer offered.)
