SPEAKER NICHOL: Dr. Robert Palmer of the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Lincoln. Dr. Palmer.

DR. ROBERT PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you, Dr. Palmer. We appreciate your coming out on a morning like this and we will try to see to it that you get an extra star in your crown. Thank you. Roll call, please. Please record your presence. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you have any corrections to the Journal this morning, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir, I have no corrections this morning.
