

SENATOR LABEDZ PRESIDING

SENATOR LABEDZ: I believe we will get started. We have this morning Reverend Fred J. Wolf from Friedens Lutheran Church on 6th and D Street from Lincoln, Nebraska that will give the prayer this morning. Please rise.

REVEREND WOLF: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Reverend Wolf. Will the members please record your presence. Roll call. Senator Goodrich informs me that I have to ring the bell before you can record your presence.
