SPEAKER NICHOL: (Microphone not activated immediately.)

PRESIDENT: Members of the Legislature, please report to the  
Legislative Chamber where we are attempting to acquire a  
quorum to begin our daily business the first day of the  
week, the 59th day. Welcome to the Legislative Chamber.  
Roll call is in progress. Members, please record your  
presence on roll call. Members, please record your presence  
and we will determine our numbers and proceed. Record the  
roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum present. (Gavel.) The Legislature is in  
session. Do you have corrections to the minutes, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, I received a series of audit reports  
from the State Auditor. I received reports for the  
Agricultural Activities, State Board of Land Surveyors,  
Department of Personnel, Board of Examiners for Professional  
Engineers and Architects, Board of Trustees - State  
Colleges, the Accountability and Disclosure Commission, the  
District Courts, Department of Education, the Nebraska  
Gasohol Committee, Department of Public Institutions, the  
Department of Aeronautics, the Nebraska Educational  
Television Commission, and the Public Employees' Retirement
