SPEAKER NICHOL: (Microphone not activated.) ...Westminster Presbyterian Church in Lincoln. Dr. Palmer.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Remmers, would you like to go on our resolution 272? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Remmers offers 272, which is on page 2339 of the Journal. It asks the Legislature to name the health, physical education and recreation building at Peru State College after Mr. Al Wheeler.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Remmers, please.

SENATOR REMMERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the state approved a fine health, physical education, recreation center at Peru College. It was finished in 1980. It is a very fine building, but it's never been named. There are many people that feel that a building of that type, on a state college, should be named, of course it would take the approval of the Legislature. LR 272 proposes to name the field house at Peru State College for a long time Peru State teacher and coach, Al Wheeler. The field house, which includes a swimming pool and basketball, volleyball and tennis courts, is currently called the Health, Physical Education Recreation Center, or
