

PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Recorder not activated)...Dr. Robert Palmer.

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Dr. Palmer, and, members, please record your presence for roll call.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A quorum is present and the Legislature is in session for the 86th legislative day. Are there corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Item 4, messages, reports, and announcements.

CLERK: One item, Mr. President, a new resolution, LR 287, by Senator Eret. It acknowledges the passing of Mr. William Krejci and extends its sympathy to the family. That will be laid over, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very well, at this time the Chair would recognize the Speaker, Senator Nichol. (Gavel.) Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, you will recall that yesterday I told you to bring your toothbrushes because we may go late tonight. Senator Wesely and Senator Chronister have accommodated me with toothbrushes, so if any of you forgot yours, I will be willing to share mine with you. So plan to stay late tonight. But just in the way of what is planned ahead in our short four days after today, for all practical purposes, today is the last day for General File. Now it is possible but very improbable that if anything gets off of General File after today, it may not not fair too well the rest of the day, the rest of this session. We will go on budget bills for as long as necessary today and tomorrow, and should the budget bills debate be completed today, tomorrow's agenda will include some Final Reading and Select File. LB 460, I understand, is necessary according to the budget package adopted that it would be placed on Special Order on General File tomorrow as well. Monday, which is
