PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: This morning we have a chaplain from the Seventh-Day Adventist College View Church, the Reverend Terry Bock.

REVEREND BOCK: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you very much, Reverend Bock. Members, record your presence for roll call.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum present. (Gavel.) The Legislature is in session. Are there corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

CLERK: Just one item, Mr. President. I have a Reference Report referring LB 984-1028 with certain exceptions. That is offered by Senator Beutler as Chairman of the board. Senator Conway would like to add his name to LB 1021.

PRESIDENT: Without objection? So ordered. Senator Beutler, I am asked by the Clerk to recognize you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you, Mr. President. I just wanted to note for the members of the Legislature that you will be seeing, on your desk, a memorandum from the Bill Drafter's Office, from me actually, but from the Bill Drafter's Office indicating that bill requests submitted to the bill drafting staff by Friday of this week, before 5:00 p.m., will be guaranteed ready for introduction before the adjournment on the tenth legislative day, which of course is the last legislative day for introducing new bills. Those that are received after 5:00 p.m. Friday, they will do their best to get them done, but there will be no guarantee. This is the same kind of cutoff that we have to make every year and we make it as late as possible. The Bill Drafting Office has indicated, with the work load that they have this year, that Friday at 5:00 p.m. is the deadline. So be aware of that and get your stuff in before 5:00 p.m., unless you want to take a risk with it. Thank you.
