SENATOR CARSTEN PRESIDING

SENATOR CARSTEN: The body will come to order for a prayer. We are privileged this morning to have Reverend Al J. Norden, father of one of my legislative counsels in years gone by, and we are delighted that he has come back to give us our prayer this morning. Reverend Norden, would you please.

Mr. President, I have a series of appointment letters from the Governor and they will be referred to the Reference Committee for ultimate referral to the appropriate Standing Committee for a confirmation hearing. I have an Attorney General's opinion.

Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 1105 to Select File, LB 1105A, LB 1190, LB 1080, LB 931, and LB 870, all to Select File, some of which have E & R amendments attached, Mr. President. (See pages 1818-19 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have, Mr. President.
