SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: (Recorder not activated) legislative floor. We have six days left and this morning we have with us from Ralston, Nebraska, a guest of Senator Chris Abboud, Father Foster of the St. Gerald's Catholic Church. Father Foster, please.
