SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Good morning. Welcome to the Legislative Chambers of the Nebraska Legislature. We have with us this morning our own Chaplain, Dr. Robert Palmer of the Westminster Presbyterian Church. Will you please rise?

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: (Gavel.) Thank you, Dr. Palmer, again. Appreciate it. Roll call, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any corrections to the Journal this morning?

CLERK: No, sir, no corrections.

SPEAKER NICHOL: How about messages, reports, or announcements, please?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have two Attorney General Opinions, the first to Senator Haberman regarding LBs 516, 529, 153, and 122, and one to Senator Schmit regarding LB 835. Those will both be inserted in the Journal. (See pages 2019-30 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we will move on to LB 926.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 926 was a bill that was introduced by the Health and Human Services Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, Mr. President, of this year. It was referred to Health and Human Services. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by the Health and Human Services Committee.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, would you like to take up the bill or the amendments, whichever you think should be first?

SENATOR WESELY: We can go ahead with the committee amendment, Mr. Speaker. Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members, I will be very brief and, hopefully, this bill won't take very much time.
